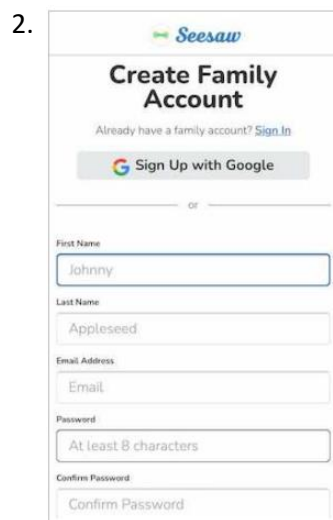
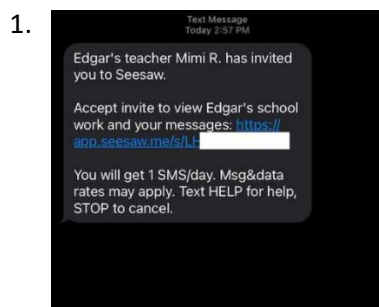

Dear Parents/Carers,

At Discovery we will be using a platform called Seesaw as a tool for home-school communication, to set homework and to capture pupil's learning. Seesaw is a fantastic tool that empowers our pupils to independently document their learning and provides an authentic audience for their work. For families, Seesaw gives an immediate and personalised window into your child's school day and makes communication with teachers easy.

You should have received a text message containing a link with instructions about how to connect to your child's Seesaw journal. You will be prompted to download the Seesaw App (available in all app stores), sign in or create a new account.



Once an account is set up, you will have access to your child's learning inside of school, be able to share any home learning and communicate directly with the teacher.

Seesaw is a closed platform, meaning only the pupils, parents and teachers (with the correct class code) will be able to access what is posted. As pupils move through school and E-Safety becomes more prominent within the curriculum, pupils within the class will be able to see all of the learning posted (parents will still only have access to the learning of their own child). This allows teachers and pupils to have important discussions about digital literacy, online comments, positive feedback and how to be a good digital citizen.

The platform will contain examples of good work, pictures and videos from school experiences, reminders for school trips/events, links to videos produced and any other highlights from the school day.

As stated, parents will be able to communicate with teachers directly. If there is something you wish to clarify, if you feel concerned over any issues, want to share some positive news or want to arrange to see us please do this
