Big Ideas promoted in our French Curriculum

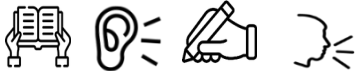


Substantive Concepts of our French Curriculum

<i>Writing</i>		<i>To express their views and opinions in written form using a range of taught vocabulary.</i> <i>To use a variety of sentence structures.</i>

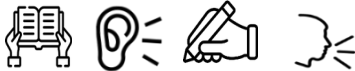

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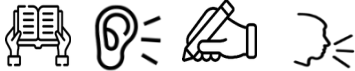
