Who We Are

In December 2024, 10 parents and carers met with Mrs Windle to discuss the idea of starting a Discovery School Fundraising Group. This was the beginning of the Friends of Discovery School Academy, which is like a Parents-Teachers Association (PTA) but wider and open to people outside of the parent/ carer community if they would like to help us raise funds.

Why open it wider as a Friends Association rather than a PTA?

The parents and carers of our older children might want to continue to be members of this group after their children have left the school. Grandparents, aunts, uncles and others may want to help us fundraise and join the group. Maybe even people from outside the school community would like to help us fundraise. Everyone is welcome and parents and carers are automatically members.

How can you lend your support?

You can attend our regular meetings which a staff representative will always publicise well in advance. If you can't attend regularly but can drop by occasionally to say hello and share any ideas you have for fundraising you will always be welcome; or if groups are not your thing or you are just too busy, just come along to the events we organise and help out on the night or help by simply coming and spending your money.

- › Small equipment used continuously- balls, cushions, sensory resources

- › Musical equipment

Jumble Sale in May


